Sunday, February 4 th	Short, easy walk exploring waterholes north of Telegraph Station. Flat terrain, sandy and rocky creek bed, grassy river banks, swimming. Bring a cup if you'll have a cuppa.	Nick	8953 4530
Saturday, February 10 th	Hills around Euro Ridge. Easy-Moderate. Rocky terrain, spinifex, some ascents and descents.	Nannette	0409 377 545
Sunday, February 18 th	Easy walk along the Todd River	Sue	0417 814 745
Saturday, February 24 th	Moderate-hard walk. Steep & high, rocky ascent and descent. Start at Simpson's Gap, climb up the eastern ridge and walk east to a saddle, then descend to join section 1 of Larapinta trail and return to start via Hat Hill Saddle.	Nannette	0409 377 545
Sunday, March 4 th	Ormiston carpark to Bowman's gap and return through Ormiston pound and Ormiston Gorge. Medium-hard full-day walk. Steep, rocky climb and descent, some scrambling, rocky off-track terrain, spinifex. Bring gaiters or long pants.	Rosalie	8953 4530
Saturday, March 10 th	Moderate walk from Ellery Big Hole, east along section 6 of Larapinta Trail, up to a low saddle and over to the north of ridge, then west along a service road and 200 m swim-through Ellery Big Hole. Bring flotation gear (flotation vest or li-lo) if you can't swim 200 metres. Bring dry-sacs for your water-sensitive gear, gadgets etc.	Nannette	0409 377 545
Sunday, March 18 th	Moderate walk along Ilparpa ridge to visit wreck of Israel Aircraft Industries Westwind 1124, VH-AJS aircraft that crashed on April 27 th 1995. Not-so-steep rocky climb and descent, rocky and uneven terrain.	Sue	0417 814 745
Sunday, March 25 th	Easy walk, moderate swim/scramble/climb through the amazing Redbank Gorge.	Steve	0417 923 047
Easter LWE	Ruby Gap area. Base camp with day walks along side gorges. Variable difficulty – some steep scrambles, but stunning gorges.	Nick	8953 4530
Sunday, April 8 th	Western MacDonnell ranges mountain bike trails. Moderate – flat terrain, but 15 Km length	Diane	0477 032 250
